Here are some ideas of ways your child can earn an allowance and begin their savings journey!

Toddlers (2-3):

- Put away toys
- Fill up pet's food bowl
- Place clothing in hamper
- Wipe up spills
- Dust/wipe baseboards (using a sock on their hand)
- Organize books
- Help load washer or dryer
- Mop small areas with a dry mop

Preschoolers (4-5):

- Make their bed
- Clear the table
